Eligibility

- Students must meet the following qualifications to receive Speech and/or Languages Services:
 - Have an Individualized Education Program (IEP) and an active Service Plan (SP)
 - Have a Speech or Language Impairment documented on their IEP or SP
- If a Speech or Language Impairment is suspected, parents should call their local public school to request testing

Overview of Services

- Services are provided on-campus by a Speech and Language Pathologist through Brevard Public Schools
- Sessions are held weekly in a small group format for 30 minutes
- Only students in grades K – 6 are eligible for these services
