5. To increase awareness of community resources.

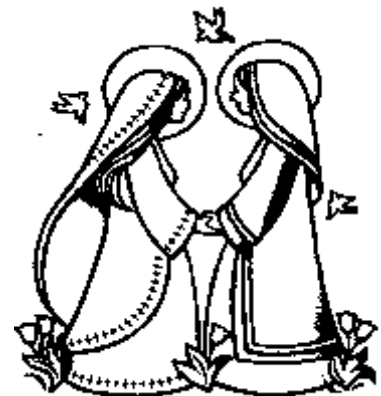
BACKGROUND

Grace Within is a program that follows the one called Ministry of Mother's Sharing (M.O.M.S.) that was created by Sr. Paula Hagen, O.S.B. in the fall of 1986. She started it with a group of mothers at St. Timothy Parish in Mesa, Arizona. It was designed to encourage prayer, discussion and friendship among mothers of ALL AGES. M.O.M.S. has spread all over the country and is encouraged and flourishing all over the Diocese of Orlando. Here at Our Lady of Lourdes we begin our sessions in JANUARY, watch the bulletin for additional registration information. Many of the girls continue to grow by meeting together several times during the year.

STRUCTURE

This ongoing peer ministry begins with a series of ten structured sessions, with prayer rituals, reflection and journaling.

- Session 2 Self-acceptance and self esteem
- Session 3 Everyday Spirituality
- Session 4 Feelings
- Session 5 Personal Growth

- Session 7 Discernment: Continuing the Journey
- Session 8 Retreat
- Session 9 Celebrating New Beginnings
